legendary conducting pedagogue Gustav
Meier. While studying at the Peabody, he

Symphony Orchestra, and Maestro
Christian Badea and Maestro Oliver von
Dohananyi with the Baltimore Opera
Company. In addition, Jong-hun is the
winner of the 2015 International
Conductors Competition in Atlanta, GA.
